What makes you eligible for an Adult Scholarship?

To be eligible for Newfoundland Labrador Housing's Adult Scholarship Program, you must be either:

1. renting from Newfoundland Labrador Housing, and your signature appears on the rental lease;
2. receiving a rent supplement from Housing;
3. receiving a mortgage subsidy from Housing, and your signature appears on the mortgage document; or
4. living in Co-op housing or Community-Based housing which is being subsidized by Newfoundland Labrador Housing and your signature appears on the occupancy agreement or lease.

You must also meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. Must be attending or planning to attend a post-secondary institution approved by the Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Education in the Fall of 2010; and must be enrolled in a full-time program and be in attendance through to December 31, 2010. This attendance must be confirmed.
2. Must submit an application form along with a written statement outlining your interest in returning to school and your future goals.
3. Be prepared to review your statement with a Housing representative at a local regional office. Appointments will be scheduled after all applicants have been screened.

NOTE:

1. Information on the application form must be valid at the time the application is reviewed for eligibility.
2. Should you change post-secondary institutions after you submit your application, please contact Housing at 724-3003 to have your application updated.
3. If you are renting or receiving a mortgage subsidy from Housing, your account must be in good standing at the time your application is reviewed for eligibility.
4. Graduates from Adult Basis Education (ABE) are eligible to apply. This scholarship is not limited to first-year students.
5. Adult scholarships will be awarded based on reviews that assess initiative, need, and community involvement.
