Scholarships will be awarded based on the results of the Newfoundland and Labrador "Department of Education Scholarship Score" which is derived from a student's performance on the Newfoundland and Labrador Provincial Public Exams.

What makes you eligible for a Youth Scholarship?

To be eligible for Newfoundland Labrador Housing's Youth Scholarship Program, your legal guardian would have to be either:

- 1) renting from Newfoundland Labrador Housing, and their signature(s) appear on the rental lease;
- 2) receiving a rent supplement from Housing;
- 3) receiving a mortgage subsidy from Housing, and their signature(s) appear on the mortgage document; or
- 4) living in Co-op housing or Community-Based housing which is being subsidized by Newfoundland Labrador Housing and their signature(s) appear on the occupancy agreement or lease.

You must also meet the following eligibility requirements:

- 1) have been a Level III high school student in 2010 (completing Level III in June 2010);
- 2) be attending any post-secondary institution approved by the Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Education on a full-time basis in the fall of 2010.

NOTE:

- 1) Information on the application form must be valid at the time the application is reviewed for eligibility.
- 2) Should you change post-secondary institutions after you submit your application, please contact Housing at 724-3003 to have your application updated.
